



This event is meant to help you learn about different AWS services that can help you on your journey into the cloud! To get started you can click on a circle with the servers within it. The different colors of the circles refer to the difficulty (Green = Easy, Yellow = Medium, Red = Hard), and the points next to the circle refer to the maximum number of points that you can score on that challenge.

If you only see thumbs up icons, that is okay too! That just means that another member of your team has already completed that challenge. You attempt each of these challenges as a team. You will access the same AWS account to fix the problem as a team. You earn points as a team. If you decide to use a clue to get some help, the maximum score your team can earn for that challenge is reduced.

A few of other details:

- Please wait to start a challenge until you are ready to begin working on it. This will ensure that everyone can try the challenges that they want to.
- Your team is allowed restart each challenge one time. Use this if someone else on your team already completed that challenge, but you want to try it as well. Or if you made a configuration change to an account and now can't complete the challenge. Keep in mind you will not earn additional points for solving the same challenge multiple times.
- If this Jam is awarding prizes, you can see how many prizes you have earned from within your Account which can be accessed by clicking on your username on the top right.

Enjoy your Jam and if you have any questions, just raise your hand and one of the event facilitators will be able to answer your questions!
